- ___ 2) Three students were passing notes at the back of the classroom.
- ___ 3) The teacher asked the class to get quiet 45 times in a 90-minute block.
- ___ 4) The students had a hard time working in groups.
- ___ 5) The warm-up took 18 minutes to complete.
- ___ 6) The teacher has a good relationship with the students.
- ___ 7) There was a lot of noise at the beginning of class.
- ___ 8) There are very few procedures/routines in place.
- ___ 9) The students were confused by the directions given for the group assignment.
- ___ 10) Five students asked individually for the same directions to be repeated.
- ___ 11) Half of the class completed the activity with more than 10 minutes to spare.
- ___ 12) The teacher spent at least 3 minutes with each group during the group activity.
